The presentation focused on the importance of getting enough sleep in order to be able to function at your job. When employees are sleepy they do not think as fast, remember as well, learn as effectively, or pay attention as long. Falling asleep at the wheel can cause an accident and potential injury to you or another person. Stay safe and be sure to get the appropriate amount of sleep every night which is 6 to 8 hours.
