## WEATHER-WISE TRAVEL TIPS

Brush up on snow safety with this quick review

### ✓ DO

- Dress warmly in layers and wear slip-resistant footwear when possible.
- Always wait on the sidewalk, at a cleared driveway, or nearby corner.
- Remember to allow those exiting the vehicle to go first - then board safely.
- Be aware of the gap between the curb and vehicle.
- Use handrails when entering and exiting the vehicle. TransNet vehicles feature non-slip floors but extra caution is always encouraged.
- Remember to stand clear of the doors so they have safe, sufficient room to open.

### ✗ DON'T

- Never leave your location without confirming that your mobile phone/device is accessible, charged and powered on.
- Don't rush - allow extra time.
- Never wait in the street.
- Don't approach vehicle until it comes to a complete stop.
- Don't rest wet items on seats.
- Personal items cannot be placed in the aisle.
- Don't forget that your footwear may be wet and proceed with caution at your destination.
