Fire Evacuation Drills

According to Section 15-1517 of the Public School Code of 1949, Fire Evacuation Drills are mandated by the state two times a year during the months of September and March. These drills are extremely important to be certain all drivers and aides know the protocal if their vehicle is ever on fire. The training includes the practice and instruction concerning the location, use and operation of emergency exit doors and windows, fire extinguishers and the proper evacuation of the vehicle.
