Updating Consumer Information

In January 2018, TransNet will be adding two new features for the convenience of the consumers.

- Interactive Voice Recognition (IVR) will automatically call our consumer the night before to remind them of their scheduled ride with the option to cancel, if necessary. On the day of the trip, another call will automatically be generated to let them know that their ride is on the way.
- Find My Ride PA will enable the consumer to schedule a ride, confirm their ride, or cancel their ride via computer or smart phone.

To take advantage of these upcoming features, riders will need to update or confirm their telephone numbers. Each partner location was given postcards for the drivers to distribute to the consumer as they enter the vehicle. All drivers will then collect the postcards as the consumer exits the vehicle and will then give them to management.

Fall Jackets

All employees were given the opportunity to receive a fall jacket from TransNet. These jackets are considered to be part of the uniform when a jacket is needed in inclement weather. Thank you for all your hard work and dedication to the organization.


Referral & Recruitment Bonuses
