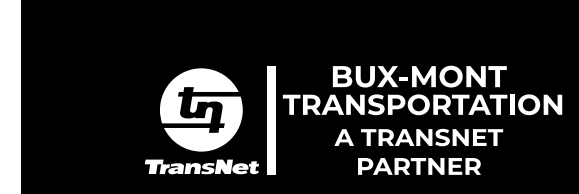


DUE WITH RESERVATION:
