
Are You Prepared?

Are you aware that TransNet and our partners have a Driver/Aide Recruitment program? You have a chance to receive \$250.00! If you refer someone and they are employed for 6 months you will receive \$250.00. They in turn receive \$250.00 after 6 months and then an additional \$250.00 after a year. As part of this program, business cards can be obtained from your manager and can be given to someone who may be interested in becoming a driver or vehicle aide. If you know someone, write your name on the back of the business card, and ask the applicant to give the business card to the manager when they are interviewed. If they are hired and remain employed for 6 months, \$250.00 is yours!
